
COLORADO'S AAC PROGRAM COMPLIANCE WITH THE COVERED OUTPATIENT DRUGS FINAL RULE

Colorado already meets the ingredient and professional dispensing fee requirements of the final rule


- HCPF reimburses pharmacies based on a state-specific AAC program for ingredient costs
- HCPF's approved State Plan requires a cost of dispensing fee survey every two state fiscal years
- HCPF contracted with Mercer to conduct a new professional dispensing fee survey


HCPF will use the results to review how the current dispensing fees compare to the current costs of dispensing





PROFILE INFORMATION

For identification and explanation of certain costs

For comparison groups and to identify statistically significant causes in varying rates

- Was there a change in pharmacy ownership during the reporting period?
- Was the pharmacy open the entire year?
- Is one or more of the pharmacists who fill prescriptions at this location also an owner of the store or chain?
- How many hours per week is the pharmacy department open? (maximum of 168 hours)

PRESCRIPTION STATISTICS

How many were filled by this pharmacy during the reporting period?

 How many FFS Medicaid prescriptions were filled during the reporting period? How many were compounded?

 How many FFS Medicaid prescriptions were compounded? How many were delivered?

 How many FFS Medicaid prescriptions were delivered to members?

SALES AND COST OF GOODS SOLD

Sales (Pharmacy)


- Prescription sales other than Over-the-Counter (OTC) dispensed by a pharmacist
- OTC sales dispensed by pharmacy department with a prescription

Sales (Non-Pharmacy)

- OTC sales by staff not in pharmacy department
- Portion of federal grants attributable to pharmacy, if any
- Other sales such as retail sales and HCPCS billed services

Cost of Goods Sold (COGS)

- Pharmaceuticals
 Note: This will not be included
 in the dispensing fee calculation
- Non-pharmacy COGS



NON-PAYROLL EXPENSES AND UNALLOWED COSTS


Direct pharmacy, non-payroll expense


CMS-defined unallowed costs (advertising, charity, income tax)

Overhead facility costs (allocated by square footage)


Overhead non-facility costs (allocated by percentage of sales)






PROFESSIONAL DISPENSING FEE SURVEY TOTAL CALCULATION
